Subject: Direct Review of the City's Conflict of Interest Code

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Direct the City Manager to have staff review the City's Conflict of Interest Code per Gov. Code 87306.5. and, if a change is necessary, file the Biennial Notice by October 1, 2024, and submit an amended Conflict of Interest Code to the Council for review before December 30, 2024.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action.

STRATEGIC PRIORITY: This item is part of the day-to-day operations identified in the Adopted FY 2023-24 Strategic Priority Project List.

DISCUSSION: Pursuant to the Political Reform Act, the City adopted a Conflict of Interest Code which consists of standard provisions contained in Section 18730 of Title 2 of the California Code of Regulations, as amended. The Code also designates City officials, officers, employees, and consultants who make or participate in making governmental decisions which may affect their financial interests, who must disclose those interests in certain financial disclosure statements.

The Political Reform Act requires the City Council, as the code reviewing body, to direct staff to review the Code by July 1 of each even-numbered year. Staff must then submit a biennial notice to Council by October 1 indicating whether amendments are needed. If so, the amended Code will be presented to Council for approval by resolution.
