Subject: Amendment to Agreement with American Global Security, Inc.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Authorize the Mayor to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with American Global Security, Inc.

FISCAL IMPACT: No additional appropriation is required. Funding for this agreement is included in the Adopted Budget for FY 2023-24 in Account No. 100-4010-5100-00 (Park Maintenance Professional Services) and Account No. 100-4011-5107-00 (Special Events Contract Personnel).

STRATEGIC PRIORITY: This item is part of the day-to-day operations identified in the Adopted FY 2023-24 Strategic Priority Project List.

DISCUSSION: On July 10, 2023, Council approved a Professional Services Agreement (Agreement) with American Global Security (Consultant) to provide professional security services at City parks, special events, and facility rentals. The Consultant's primary responsibilities include locking and securing the Malibu Equestrian Park, Las Flores Creek Park, and Trancas Canyon Park seven days a week, 365 days a year, and no additional fees are required to complete the daily services and fees will remain at \$37,800.

Staff is recommending this amendment to the agreement to cover additional costs necessary for the Consultant to provide security personnel for special events. In early 2024, staff completed an Emergency Action, Pedestrian, and Traffic Safety Plan for the Chumash Day Powwow and Intertribal Gathering. As a result, additional security personnel and crossing guards were recommended for the event, resulting in expenses of approximately \$4,000. Security personnel also work at Malibu Bluffs Park during high-traffic holidays, such as Independence Day, and art exhibition openings (when needed).

The additional cost for security coverage for special events will not exceed \$24,900 annually. Renters will pay expenses incurred for facility rental security.

Since the initiation of the agreement, the consultant has provided great customer service, been responsive, and met the Department's expectations. Staff recommends that the Council approve Amendment No. 1 with American Global Security for additional special event security.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT is made and entered in the City of Malibu on June 24, 2024, by and between the CITY OF MALIBU, hereinafter referred to as City, and American Global Security, Inc., hereinafter referred to as Consultant.

The City and the Consultant agree as follows:

RECITALS

A. On July 10, 2023, the City entered into an Agreement with Consultant to secure the Malibu Equestrian Park, Las Flores Creek Park, and Trancas Canyon Park every day at closing. Additional security services included special events and facility rentals, as needed (the "Agreement").

B. The City desires to amend the Agreement to increase the annual compensation for special event services, and Consultant has submitted a proposal for this purpose that is acceptable to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual promises, obligations and covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Section 4.0 – Compensation for Services, of the Agreement, is hereby amended to the cost of daily services shall be \$3,150 per month, and \$24,900 annually for special events for a total amount not to exceed \$63,000 annually.
2. The Parties agree that this Amendment will be considered signed when the signature of a party is delivered physically or by facsimile transmission or scanned and delivered via electronic mail. Such facsimile or electronic mail copies will be treated in all respects as having the same effect as an original signature.
3. All terms and conditions of the Agreement not amended by this Amendment No. 1 remain in full force and effect.
