Subject: Acceptance of Storm Drain Trash Screen Installation Phase II Project

RECOMMENDED ACTION: 1) Accept the work performed by United Storm Water, Inc. for the Storm Drain Trash Screen Installation Phase II Project, Specification No. 2102 as complete; and 2) Authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact with accepting the work as complete. Funding for this project is included in the Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-23 Account No. 310-9104-5100-00 (Storm Drain Trash Screens Phase Two). This project is funded using Measure W.

WORK PLAN: This item was included as a 4.r item in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2022-23. Staff continue to work on ongoing projects and normal business while the FY 2023-24 Work Plan is finalized.

DISCUSSION: On May 8, 2023, City Council awarded the Storm Drain Trash Screen Installation Phase Project to United Storm Water, Inc. This project included the installation of trash screens on seven (7) storm drain inlets on John Tyler Drive, Roca Chica Drive and Piedra Chica Drive. In compliance with the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) mandates to reduce the amount of trash entering the storm drain system.

The work is now complete. Staff recommends the City Council to accept the work performed by United Storm Water, Inc. and authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion for the project.

STAFF FOLLOW-UP: Upon acceptance by the City Council of the work associated with this contract, staff will record the Notice of Completion with the Los Angeles County Registrar/Recorder's Office which will allow the City to then release the retention monies following a required 35-day holding period.
