Subject: Appeal No. 23-007 - Appeal of the Planning Director's denial of Temporary Use Permit No. 23-004 for the Malibu Triathlon (Location: Zuma Beach, 30050 Pacific Coast Highway, APN 4469-027-901, Owner: Los Angeles County, Applicant/Appellant: Super League Triathlon)

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**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Adopt Resolution No. 23-46 (Exhibit A), denying Appeal No. 23-007 (Exhibit B), and denying Temporary Use Permit (TUP) No. 23-004 for the Malibu Triathlon in the Public Open Space (OS) zoning district at 30050 Pacific Coast Highway (Los Angeles County).

**DISCUSSION:** The matter is an appeal of the Planning Director's denial of TUP No. 23-004, an application for the Malibu Triathlon, to be held on September 30, 2023, and October 1, 2023. On September 18, 2023, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the matter, which resulted in a deadlock vote. Pursuant to Malibu Municipal Code (MMC) 17.04.220(F), in the event an appeal from an action of the planning manager/director results in a deadlock vote by the planning commission, the decision of the planning manager/director shall be reinstated unless appealed to the City Council. Subsequent to the Planning Commission meeting, the applicant appealed the Planning Director's action. As such, the matter before the City Council is an appeal of the Planning Director's denial of the subject TUP.

## Background

The TUP application was submitted to the City on March 8, 2023, and was denied by the Planning Director on September 8, 2023 (Exhibit C) for the following reasons: 1) the

applicant did not provide an adequate racecourse design to the City in time for both the public notice and decision; 2) the Public Works Department did not approve the application, in time for the public notice, since the proposed racecourse posed a public safety issue as it included the flooded undercrossing at Busch Drive and alternative courses proposed additional road closures; and as such, 3) staff could not make the necessary findings for a TUP approval as required by MMC Section 17.68.060. The appellant filed a timely appeal of the Planning Director's denial of TUP No. 23-004 on September 11, 2023 (Exhibit B).

The Malibu Triathlon proposed using its traditional racecourse, consisting of a swim along Zuma Beach, an out-and-back run along Westward Beach Road, and a bike ride along Pacific Coast Highway, that connects to Zuma Beach parking lot via an underpass at Busch Drive (Exhibit D). MMC Sections 17.68.050(B) and (D) require that the Planning Director mail a public notice to all property owners and tenants within a 500-foot radius of the subject property and not less than 32 days prior to the proposed event. The notice for the event was required to be mailed on August 24, 2023, since the setup was to commence on September 25, 2023. Given that staff did not have a final racecourse by this date, staff did not have a complete project description or confirmed noticing radius, and therefore, the public notice was not mailed.

Additionally, MMC Section 17.68.050(E) requires that the Planning Director render a decision 24 days prior to the proposed use. Because a final racecourse design and associated approvals were not completed at the time the decision was required to be rendered which was September 1, 2023, the Planning Director could not approve the application within the required 24-day window.

As of September 8, 2023, the date of the Planning Director's action, a final racecourse design had not been approved. On September 12, 2023, as part of the appeal to the Planning Commission, the applicant identified an alternative route that is under review. The alternative route proposes a right turn onto Westward Beach Road to connect to the Zuma Beach access instead of the traditional underpass at Busch Drive (Exhibit E). The Public Works Department reviewed the alternative course during the appeal process and has found that it can meet the requirements but as of the date of preparation of this report, the final Public Works referral has not been obtained by the applicant.

On September 18, 2023, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the item which resulted in a deadlocked 2-2 vote on both motions to approve and to deny.

The item before the Council is an appeal of the Planning Director's denial of the subject TUP. Staff recommends the City Council examine all evidence in the record and adopt the resolution denying the appeal for this project because while there appears to be a safe and final course design supplied to staff during the appeal process, staff is unable to issue a 32-day notice prior to the event date.

## **Appeal to the City Council**

The appellant's specific argument in support of the appeal is noted below in *italics*. The full text of the appeal documents can be found in Exhibit B. Staff's response follows the appeal item.

### **Appeal Item 1**

*"Several factors outside of our control led to the Zuma Underpass not being available for the event, as it is a critical component of the bike course. Flooding often affects the Zuma Underpass, and Beaches and Harbors typically clears out debris prior to our event. In some years, standing water has remained and we have been able to build a temporary ramp over the water. This year, we were notified on August 28, that there was no possible way to use or disturb the ecosystem of the Zuma Underpass, given that an endangered fish (Tidewater Goby) had taken residence in the standing water."*

### **Staff Response**

As stated previously, the City did not have adequate materials and approvals at the time required to properly notice the event and render a decision. Additionally, the Planning Director could not make the findings for approval as required by MMC Section 17.68.060 because the application materials submitted at the time were insufficient to prove that the racecourse was adequate to support the use and that the use would not jeopardize public safety.

### **Appeal Item 2**

*"Definitive notification of the issue with the Underpass was made on August 28 by Beaches and Harbors, this was confirmed by City of Malibu that week as well via phone. Both notifications took place AFTER the passing of a notification deadline of August 24 that has been cited for the City to send out notifications to impacted residents."*

### **Staff Response**

Although staff understands the constraints put on the applicant by environmental factors, it is the applicant's responsibility to provide adequate materials to the City by the deadlines required by the MMC. The underpass had been flooded well before the public notice was required to be issued. As such, the applicant is responsible for ensuring the proposed racecourse is viable at the time of filing an application to ensure public noticing can occur.

### Appeal Item 3

*“The 32-day notification deadline / requirement has also since been called into question and this is another point for discussion in our appeal. Some members of the Planning Commission even noted that a 5-day notification period could be viewed as viable in the city code.”*

#### Staff Response

MMC Section 17.68.050(D) requires that a Notice of Application be mailed not less than 32 days prior to the proposed event. Although the first paragraph of the section suggests that a five-day public notice shall be provided, City practice has been to honor the 32-day notice in order to give the public enough time to review the application materials. Additionally, MMC Section 17.04.070(A) provides that where conflicts occur between the regulations of the MMC and the building code or other regulations effective within the city, the more restrictive of any such regulations shall apply. Thus, City staff has utilized the 32-day notice as the more restrictive of the noticing periods. Typically, this provision is relied upon when there are separate and distinct sections in the different titles/chapters of the MMC. Here, as noted at the Planning Commission, the reference to a 5-day notification and then to a 32-day notification occurs in the same section –MMC Section 17.68.050. Staff did rely on the underlying principle found in MMC Section 17.04.070 in applying the 32-day notice but this intra-section application is relatively unique.

### Appeal Item 4

*“We have worked proactively, and in good faith, to develop an alternate and safe bike course that is much smaller than the original course which was submitted with our TUP application in March 2023. This course has been approved by the City of Malibu Public Works and other relevant agencies. This course sits within the original footprint of the bike course but is significantly smaller and does not block any private driveways. There is always an open lane for vehicular traffic on Southbound PCH.”*

#### Staff Response

As stated previously, a final racecourse design and associated approvals were not completed at the time the decision was required to be rendered, and as such, the Planning Director could not approve the application. The applicant is to provide alternatives in a timely manner so that staff can determine if the newly proposed course needs an additional noticing radius and so that the Planning Director can make a decision within the time required by the MMC. The course accepted by the Public Works Department as part of the appeal to the Planning Commission was not submitted until September 12, 2023. This was 19 days after the 32-day notice period and 11 days after the decision was to be rendered by the Planning Director.



## Appeal Item 5

*“Had the City of Malibu provided notice based on the original course in August (or February when the data was submitted), and then notified us that Zuma wasn’t available to us, we could have gone forth with the current modified course.”*

### Staff Response

As stated previously, it is the applicant’s responsibility to ensure their course meets the requirements of the MMC. During review of the proposed course, City Staff informed the applicant that the Zuma undercrossing may not be functional because of flooding and alternatives were needed. In March 2023, when the application was submitted, it was unclear whether the racecourse would be ready in time for the event.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW: The Planning Director has analyzed the proposed event pursuant to the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Planning Director finds that pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15270, CEQA does not apply to projects that a public agency rejects or disapproves.

CORRESPONDENCE: Correspondence received for the September 18, 2023, Planning Commission hearing is attached hereto as Exhibit F.

PUBLIC NOTICE: The Notice of Application for the TUP was not issued for the aforementioned reasons. However, for the matter before the Council, on September 21, 2023, an Amended City Council Regular Meeting Agenda was posted 24 hours in advance of the meeting.

ALTERNATIVE: Should the City Council reach a different conclusion, upholding the appeal and approving the event, staff will amend the resolution to reflect the City Council’s action. Exhibit G to this report contains a previously issued TUP for this event and provides event conditions for the Council’s consideration. In addition, the Council may direct staff to publicly notice the event to all owners and occupants within a 500-foot radius of the racecourse on September 26, 2023.

SUMMARY: Based on the record as a whole, including but not limited to all written and oral testimony offered in connection with this matter, staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 23-46 denying Appeal No. 23-007, upholding the denial of TUP No. 23-004 for the Malibu Triathlon.

## RESOLUTION NO. 23-46

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF MALIBU DENYING APPEAL NO. 23-007 AND DENYING TEMPORARY USE PERMIT NO. 23-004 FOR THE MALIBU TRIATHLON IN THE PUBLIC OPEN SPACE ZONING DISTRICT AT 30050 PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY (LOS ANGELES COUNTY)

The City Council of the City of Malibu does hereby find, order and resolve as follows:

#### SECTION 1. Recitals.

A. On March 8, 2023, an application for Temporary Use Permit (TUP) No. 23-004 was submitted by the applicant, Super League Triathlon, for the Malibu Triathlon to the City of Malibu.

B. On September 8, 2023, the Planning Director issued a denial of TUP No. 23-004, on the grounds that staff did not have proper materials to issue the public notice in time, to render the decision, or to make the findings for approval as required in Malibu Municipal Code Section 17.68.060.

C. On September 11, 2023, the Planning Director's action was appealed by Super League Triathlon to the Planning Commission.

D. On September 13, 2023, a Planning Commission Meeting amended agenda was posted 24 hours in advance of the meeting.

On September 18, 2023, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed hearing on the subject application, reviewed and considered the staff report, reviewed and considered written reports, public testimony, and other information in the record. The hearing resulted in a 2-2 deadlock vote, with one Commissioner absent. Pursuant to Malibu Municipal Code (MMC) Section 17.04.220(F), the Planning Director's denial was reinstated unless appealed to the City Council

E. On September 19, 2023, the Planning Director's action was appealed by Super League Triathlon to the City Council.

F. On September 21, 2023, a City Council Meeting amended agenda was posted 24 hours in advance of the meeting.

G. On September 25, 2023, the City Council held a duly noticed hearing on the subject application, reviewed and considered the staff report, reviewed and considered written reports, public testimony, and other information in the record.

#### SECTION 2. Environmental Review.

Pursuant to the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the City Council has analyzed the proposed project. The City Council found that the provisions of CEQA do not apply to the project since it is a denial pursuant to Section 15270 – Projects that are Disapproved.

SECTION 3. Findings for Denying the Appeal.

The appellant contends that several factors outside of their control forced a redesign of the intended routes for the event. The factors included severe flooding and the creation of an environmentally sensitive area around the Zuma Underpass which has impacted their ability to use the proposed racecourse. The racecourse had not been finalized before the deadline for the City to issue the 32-day public notice nor was it finalized prior to the 24-day deadline to render a decision, and therefore, the Planning Director denied TUP No. 23-004.

Based on evidence contained within the record, including the agenda report for the project and the hearing on September 25, 2023, and pursuant to the MMC, the City Council adopts the findings of fact, denying the appeal and finds that substantial evidence in the record to deny TUP No. 23-004. In addition, the analysis, findings of fact, as well as the testimony and materials considered by the City Council are incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

A. The City Council finds that the City did not have adequate materials and approvals at the time required to properly notice the event and render a decision.

B. It is the applicant's responsibility to provide adequate materials to the City by the deadlines required by the MMC. The underpass had been flooded well before the notice was required to be sent out. As such, the applicant is responsible for ensuring the racecourse can be used before the event is noticed to the public.

C. The City Council could not make the findings for approval as required by MMC Section 17.68.060 because the materials proposed at the time were insufficient to prove that the racecourse was adequate to support the use and that the use would not jeopardize public safety.

SECTION 4. City Council Action.

Based on the foregoing findings and evidence contained within the record, the City Council hereby denies Appeal No. 23-007 and upholds the Planning Director's denial of TUP No. 23-004.

SECTION 5. The City Council shall certify the adoption of this resolution.

Only matters raised in the appeal shall be subject to review. Any matters not raised in the appeal shall not be subject to consideration by the appellate body. The purpose of this limitation is to provide adequate notice to all parties with respect to the issues on appeal and eliminate the necessity of rehearing matters not subject to challenge. Although the issues on appeal will be limited by the appeal, the appellate body will accept new evidence (de novo appeal) and will not be bound by the previous record. [MMC Section 17.04.220(B)]

An appeal shall be filed with the City Clerk within 10 days following the date of action for which appeal is made. Appeals shall be accompanied by the filing fee as specified by the City Council. An appellant shall have an additional 10 days following the date of filing the appeal to submit to the City Clerk in writing, the specific grounds for the appeal. The owners should be listed first followed by the occupants. The project applicant's mailing address should be added at the end of the list.
- An additional column for "arbitrary number" may be included if the supplied radius map utilizes such numbers for the purpose of correlating the addressee to their map location.
- Printouts of the excel spreadsheet and radius map, certified by the preparer as being accurate, must be provided.
- The radius map (8½" x 11") shall show a 500-foot radius\* from the subject property and must show a minimum of 10 developed properties. A digital copy of the map shall be submitted on the same cd as the mailing addresses.

\*Properties zoned RR-10, RR-20, or RR-40 require a 1,000-foot radius notification.

\*\*Note that updated mailing labels may be requested by the project planner prior to deeming the application complete.

On September 8, 2023, we received a letter from Richard Molica, Planning Director for the City of Malibu, that our TEMPORARY USE PERMIT No. 23-004 (Malibu Triathlon Planned for September 30 – October 1, 2023) had been denied.

We appealed that decision with the Planning Commission. The item was on the agenda for the September 18th Planning Commission meeting. During that meeting, only 4 of the 5 Commissioners were present and able to vote. The vote was split 2 - 2 and based on existing rules, no action was taken and the staff recommendation to uphold the denial remained in place.

Please consider this our Appeal Letter to the Planning Commission's permit denial.

Our appeal is based on several factors that we will expand on in our Grounds of Appeal Letter. These factors include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Several factors outside of our control led to the Zuma Underpass not being available for the event, as it is a critical component of the bike course. Flooding often affects the Zuma Underpass, and Beaches and Harbors typically clears out debris prior to our event. In some years, standing water has remained and we have been able to build a temporary ramp over the water. This year, we were notified on August 28, that there was no possible way to use or disturb the ecosystem of the Zuma Underpass, given that an endangered fish (Tidewater Goby) had taken residence in the standing water.
- Definitive notification of the issue with the Underpass was made on August 28 by Beaches and Harbors, this was confirmed by City of Malibu that week as well via phone. Both notifications took place AFTER the passing of a notification deadline of August 24 that has been cited for the City to send out notifications to impacted residents.
- The 32 day notification deadline / requirement has also since been called into question and this is another point for discussion in our appeal. Some members of the Planning Commission even noted that a 5 day notification period could be viewed as viable in the city code.



- Since notification that the underpass would definitely not be available to us on August 28, we have been actively working with Public Works and other responsible agencies, on various alternative routes as contingency plans.
- We have worked proactively, and in good faith, to develop an alternate and safe bike course that is much smaller than the original course which was submitted with our TUP application in March 2023. This course has been approved by the City of Malibu Public Works and other relevant agencies. This course sits within the original footprint of the bike course, but is significantly smaller and does not block any private driveways. There is always an open lane for vehicular traffic on Southbound PCH.
- Had the City of Malibu provided notice based on the original course in August (or February when the data was submitted), and then notified us that Zuma wasn't available to us, we could have gone forth with the current modified course.
- The Malibu Triathlon currently has 3,700 people registered and planning to attend the event. We have raised almost \$1,000,000 this year and over \$18,000,000 for CHLA since we started partnering with them. The good work that CHLA does has positively impacted many Malibu residents as was highlighted at last night's meeting and the event puts the City of Malibu in a great light for supporting such a good cause and providing an event that promotes health and wellness. We believe that the City Council has the authority to approve this event.

Based on this, we request an appeal of the denial which was the outcome of the Planning Commission meeting given the split votes.

Timeline

**Background**

The Malibu Triathlon is in its 38th year in Malibu at Zuma Beach. To date, this event has raised over \$18 million for the Pediatric Cancer Research Department at Children's Hospital Los Angeles. It is an annual event for hundreds of Malibu residents, has introduced thousands of participants to the sport of triathlon, and is an icon within the world of triathlon.

For years, the Zuma Underpass has been integrated into the course as it allows bikes to safely cross under the Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) without stopping east or west bound vehicular traffic. Bikes emerge from the Zuma Underpass and proceed west on the PCH in the curbside vehicle lane, which is closed as part of our permit. The center lanes remain open to vehicular traffic throughout the day.

In years past, the Zuma Underpass and Arizona Crossing (an access road that connects Zuma Beach with Westward Beach Rd.) have experienced seasonal flooding.

- In many years, the water drained and left sand and debris in the Underpass. In those years, the Underpass would be cleaned out prior to our event to ensure safe passage for both vehicles and bikes alike.
- In some years, the underpass remained flooded and a temporary ramp was constructed by us, in order for bikes to transit the Underpass.
- Additionally, in some years, Arizona Crossing was also flooded and a temporary ramp constructed to allow runners to transit towards Westward Beach Road.
- Most recently, in 2019, the Malibu Triathlon had to build a temporary ramp through the Zuma Underpass given seasonal flooding.

**2023**

As of September 11, we have 3,700 people registered for the 2023 Malibu Triathlon and we have raised over \$850,000 for the Children's Hospital of Los Angeles, well on our way to raise \$1,000,000.

On January 12, 2023, we emailed a completed temporary use permit (TUP) application for the 2023 event. We were informed that Covid protocols had changed, and we can now submit in person.

On January 25, 2023, the T.U.P. was submitted at the Planning Desk

On January 25, SoCal Radius maps was contracted to provide radius maps for the event. This was completed and submitted on February 4, 2023.

On August 11, we spoke verbally with Mindy Sherwood at Beaches and Harbors regarding the typical clearing of the underpass and she relayed she would inquire with Zuma Beach Maintenance on the status.

On August 13, we were informed by a neighbor that she had heard that the underpass most likely would not be cleared, due to a protected fish in the flooded water.

On August 14, we received an email from City Planning, with an updated TUP checklist stating that only the LA County Fire and LA County Health items were incomplete. This checklist also indicated that the file of impacted residents had already been submitted per the permit checklist.

On August 14, we also received an email from the City of Malibu Community Services Director that there was no update on the underpass and to inquire directly with Beaches and Harbors.

On August 15, we received an email from Mindy Sherwood (Permits - Asset Management for Beaches and Harbors) stating that the underpass will be unusable and a small riser/ramp could not be erected. She shared that this directive came from agencies outside of Beaches and Harbors.

On August 15, we began to develop alternate routes and sought a meeting with Beaches and Harbors to understand the specifics of the directive, why we could not erect the ramp this year, who had directed the change and what our route options might be.

On August 28, we were able to hold a larger meeting with Beaches and Harbors Staff including Warren Ontiveros, Chief Planning Division, Ken Foreman, Chief of Operational Services on other possible solutions and to clarify what had changed from previous years when the underpass was cleared and/or a small ramp was used. It was clarified to us that CA Fish and Wildlife and the Regional Water Board had given the directive to not disturb the Zuma Underpass due to the presence of the protected Tidewater Goby.

On Thursday, August 31, we submitted a proposed bike route, utilizing only PCH up to Trancas to the West and Heathercliff to the east and Westward Beach Road.

On Tuesday, September 5, the above proposed route was rejected.

On Thursday, September 7, we received a call from Adrian Fernandez, who informed us that our permit would be denied as we passed the required date for notifications.

On Friday, September 8, we submitted a revised map to the Department of Public Works with a further reduced route, keeping cyclists on PCH between Trancas and Westward Beach Road. While this is less than ideal for event participants, and considering this is the only safe option, it is important to note that this proposed route does not directly block any residential or commercial driveways and only uses one lane of vehicular traffic on PCH and Westward Beach Dr. This route is currently being reviewed by Public Works.

On Friday, September 8, in the evening, we received a letter from the Planning Department that our permit had been denied. This denial was based upon (per Planning Department) the notification deadline.

On Monday, September 11, we submitted an Appeal Letter in person to the City Clerk regarding our permit.

On Monday, September 11 at approximately 3:30 PM PST we submitted this updated timeline and revised course map, per the suggestion of the City Clerk.

We look forward to working with the City of Malibu on a plan to make this event work in 2023.

Dear Mr. Lindner,

On **March 8, 2023**, the application listed above was submitted to the City of Malibu's Planning Department for processing. Planning Department staff has completed a review of the application and determined on September 7, 2023, that the submitted application is **DENIED**. Reasons for denial are provided below.

1. *Malibu Municipal Code (MMC) Section 17.68.050(B) and (D) requires that the Planning Director mail a public notice to all property owners and tenants within a 500 foot radius of the subject property and not less than 32 days prior to the proposed event.*

The notice for the event was required to be mailed on August 24, 2023, since the setup was to commence on September 25, 2023. As proposed the racecourse included a flooded undercrossing and alternative race routes were explored. At the time of noticing, the alternative courses proposed were not acceptable to the City's Public Works Department because they proposed additional road closures. Given that staff did not have a final racecourse, staff did not have a complete project description or confirmed noticing radius and therefore notices were not sent out.

2. *MMC Section 17.68.050(E) requires that the Planning Director render a decision 24 days prior to the proposed use.*

Similar to the finding listed above, a final racecourse design and associated approvals were not completed at the time the decision had to be rendered which was September 1, 2023. Therefore, the Planning Director could not make a determination within the required 24-day window.

3. *MMC Section 17.68.060 provides that the Planning Director may approve a temporary use permit provided that seven findings can be made. Four of the findings could not be made; A) That the operation of the requested use at the location proposed and within the time period specified is compatible with the surrounding neighborhood uses; B) That the proposed site is adequate in size and shape to accommodate the temporary use; C) That the proposed site is adequately served by streets or highways having sufficient width and improvements to accommodate the kind and quantity of traffic that such temporary use will or could reasonably generate; and E) That the proposed use will not jeopardize the public peace, safety or general welfare, or be injurious or detrimental to properties adjacent to; or in the*

*vicinity of, the proposed location of the activity.*

The four findings for approval cannot be made because staff could not ensure that the event site as proposed was able to accommodate the temporary use as proposed due to a flooded undercrossing. Additionally, staff could not make the finding that the proposed event would not jeopardize public safety, because as proposed the course included an undercrossing that is currently flooded. Staff does not know for certain if the undercrossing will be clear of flooding and safe for use by race day.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Malibu has **APPROVED** an application by Brennan Lindner of Super League Triathlon for the Malibu Triathlon and Fitness Exposition, a charity event to benefit the Los Angeles Children's Hospital and its Pediatric Cancer Research Department. The event will take place on Saturday, September 17, 2022, and Sunday, September 18, 2022. The event location is 30050 Pacific Coast Highway (Zuma Beach), a Los Angeles County-owned parcel located within the Public Open Space (OS) zoning district.

### ***Event Description***

The Malibu Triathlon is an annual event at Zuma Beach, that began in 1986. The event proposes the temporary use of the parcel located at 30050 Pacific Coast Highway for three different races: 1) the Olympic Distance Triathlon (1500m swim, 40k bike, 10k run on Saturday morning, September 17, 2022; 2) the Super Sprint Pro Race on Saturday afternoon; and 3) the Sprint Distance Triathlon (0.5-mile swim, 17-mile bike, 4-mile run on Sunday morning. The Super League Pro race is a new component to the Triathlon and will be contained completely within Zuma Beach. The Olympic and Sprint Distance races have occurred in prior years, and feature running and swimming courses within Malibu city limits, and a biking course that extends further west along Pacific Coast Highway towards Mulholland Highway and Deer Creek Road. Comparable to previous years, these races are followed by an awards ceremony and a Fitness Exposition that take place at Zuma Beach. All racecourses are shown within the approved site plans (Attachment 1).

Throughout the two-day event, parking for the public and event staff will be available at three locations: Zuma Beach parking lot, Malibu High School, and designated areas along Pacific Coast Highway and Westward Beach Road. The event includes temporary signage to help direct visitors to all designated parking areas. There will be 5,000 participants (2,500 each day including approximately 60 volunteers) expected over the two-day event. For reference, the approved parking plan are included as Figure 1 below.

The event site is located in the Appeal Jurisdiction of the California Coastal Commission (CCC), as depicted in the Post-Local Coastal Program (LCP) Certification Permit and Appeal Jurisdiction Map. Furthermore, the event site and related parking areas contain no mapped Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Area (ESHA).

Along with City Planning Department, the City Public Works, City Environmental Programs Division, Los Angeles County Department of Public Health (LACDPH), Los Angeles County Sheriff (LASD), and the Los Angeles County Fire Department (LACFD) are reviewing the event, parking, circulation and safety. Staff has received an approval from the LASD but the applicant is required to obtain all other agency approvals by prior to September 12, 2022.



### ***Event and Course Safety***

There will be Sheriff Deputies at the event site each day of the event for traffic control and permit enforcement, in addition to nine private security officers and one supervisor to monitor the athletes and spectators. The LASD has been contracted to work in coordination with a private security company to setup and monitor the bike course. Medical support, including an ambulance, for the event will be provided.

Similar to years past, the main gathering location will be at Zuma Beach, between lifeguard towers 10 and 11, and will include a main stage, grandstands, a video board, information booths, racing essentials for participants, portable restrooms, a medical tent, food trucks, and vendors promoting health products. The main site will also feature an array of amplified sound equipment for racing announcements and background music. A detailed exhibit of the main gathering site is provided within the approved site plan.

### ***Signage***

Temporary signage will be placed at the event site as well as along the triathlon course and will include multiple banners of various sizes at the finish line, run start, bike start, stage and swim finish, and vinyl tent banners denoting the function of each temporary tent. A mesh fence will be placed around the transition area, which will also include signage.

### **MALIBU MUNICIPAL CODE (MMC) CONFORMANCE**

Pursuant to MMC Section 17.68.010, a TUP is intended to allow for the short-term placement of activities, many of which would be prohibited as permanent placements, in temporary facilities, public or private buildings, open spaces, or outside of buildings. The Planning Director hereby makes the following findings of fact in support of TUP No. 22-025.

#### **Temporary Use Permit Findings (MMC Section 17.68.060)**

*Finding 1. The operation of the requested use at the location proposed and within the time period specified is compatible with the surrounding neighborhood uses.*

The proposed event directly impacts multiple properties within the City of Malibu, including Zuma Beach, Westward Beach, and Malibu High School (30215 Morning View Drive), as well as several public streets including Pacific Coast Highway, Westward Beach Road, and Morning View Drive. These are the same locations impacted by past triathlon races. Given the similar event plan as prior years, staff has determined that the proposed event—as conditioned in this permit—will be compatible with the surrounding neighborhood uses once all agency approvals have been obtained.

*Finding 2. The proposed site is adequate in size and shape to accommodate the temporary use.*

The main event will occur at Zuma Beach, which is adequate in size and shape to accommodate the temporary use. Ancillary sites such as Westward Beach and the parking lot at Malibu High School are also adequate in size and shape to accommodate the temporary use.

*Finding 3. The proposed site is adequately served by the streets or highways, having sufficient width and improvements to accommodate the kind and quantity of traffic that such temporary use will or could reasonably generate.*

The event site and associated parking sites are accessible from Pacific Coast Highway, Westward Beach Road, and Morning View Drive, which all have sufficient width and improvements to accommodate the kind and quantity of traffic. Conditions of approval are included to ensure public safety and prevent congestion on the surrounding road network.



*Finding 4. Adequate temporary parking will be available to accommodate vehicular traffic to be generated by such use.*

The applicant's parking plan must be approved by the City of Malibu Public Works Department. Event attendees will be able to park in three locations: (1) onsite at Zuma Beach; (2) the parking lot at Malibu High School; and (3) streetside along Pacific Coast Highway and Westward Beach Road in designated areas only. These parking sites combine to provide an adequate amount of parking spaces to accommodate event-related traffic.

*Finding 5. The proposed use will not jeopardize the public peace, safety or general welfare, or be injurious or detrimental to properties adjacent to, or in the vicinity of, the proposed location of the activity.*

LASD has issued an approval of the event. The event is pending reviews by the LACFD, the LACDPH, City Public Works Department, and City Environmental Programs Division to ensure that the requested use within the time period specified will not jeopardize the public peace, safety or general welfare, or be injurious or detrimental to properties adjacent to, or in the vicinity of, the proposed location of the activity. The event will take place during the times described above. All noise is subject to MMC Chapter 8.24 (Noise Ordinance). The applicant and owner acknowledge receipt of the City's noise ordinance and agree to comply with it at all times. Additionally, City staff has determined that the event is compliant with City Council Policy No. 47, the "Road Race Policy."

*Finding 6. The event shall not exceed a total of 14 calendar days and the proposed site has not been used for permitted temporary uses for more than 60 days within any one calendar year.*

The two-day event (plus eight days total of setup and tear down time) is the first TUP issued at this address in 2022. Therefore, the proposed event schedule complies with the maximum duration of 14 calendar days, and the event site complies with the cumulative temporary use limit of 60 days within any one calendar year. The project does not require a coastal development permit pursuant to LCP Local Implementation Plan (LIP) Section 13.4.9 and meet the exempt criteria as follows:

- a. The event will result in no adverse impact on opportunities for public use of or access to the area due to the proposed location and/or timing of the event either individually or together with other temporary events scheduled before or after the particular event.
- b. There will be no direct or indirect impacts from the event and its associated activities or access requirements on environmentally sensitive habitat areas, rare or endangered species, significant scenic resources, or other coastal resources as defined in this ordinance.
- c. The event has not previously required a coastal development permit to address and monitor associated impacts to coastal resources.

#### **TEMPORARY USE PERMIT NO. 22-025**

Based on the foregoing findings and evidence contained within the record, the Planning Director hereby approves TUP No. 22-025, subject to the following Conditions of approval listed below. In addition, on August 11, 2022, a notice of application was mailed to all property owners and occupants within a 500-foot radius of the subject properties (Attachment 4).

#### **Standard Conditions**

1. The property owners, and their successors in interest, shall indemnify and defend the City of Malibu and its officers, employees, and agents from and against all liability and costs relating to the City's actions concerning this project, including (without limitation) any award of litigation expenses in favor of any person or entity who seeks to challenge the validity of any of the City's actions or decisions in connection with this project. The City shall have the sole right to choose its counsel and property owners shall

reimburse the City's expenses incurred in its defense of any lawsuit challenging the City's actions concerning this project.

2. The approved event schedule is as follows:

- Event staff shall ensure that no unnecessary noise is generated during the event, including during the above listed set-up and clean-up hours.
- All temporary structures, including tents shall be set up as shown in the site plan. The applicant shall not vary from the site plan without prior approval from the City of Malibu.
- Any issued permit from the City of Malibu or other applicable agency shall be maintained on site and presented on request of any City employee, agent, or jurisdictional authority.
- The applicant shall submit a deposit with the City of Malibu for Los Angeles County Sheriff's Deputies fees for traffic control and permit enforcement, as determined by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department. The applicant shall be billed for any additional charges they may accrue at the current hourly rate and agree to pay those added charges within seven days; of the date billed. Unused funds will be refunded to the applicant.
- The applicant shall provide as many Sherriff Deputies as required by the Los Angeles County Sherriff's Department for traffic control and safety of the event.
- Amplified noise must be oriented to the west (towards the ocean) to minimize noise levels in the residential areas. The sound level shall be maintained at a level that does not disturb the peace of residents or tenants in the surrounding area. No amplified announcements shall occur prior to 7:00 AM
- Noise shall not be audible offsite prior to 7:00 AM or after 10:00 PM, including event setup and teardown activities. All noise shall be subject to MMC Section 8.24 (Noise Ordinance). Violation of the Noise Ordinance shall be cause for revocation of the permit and may result in denial of any Temporary Use Permits requested for the subject property in the future. If any agent of the City requests that the noise level be reduced, applicant shall ensure immediate compliance.
- Noise from this event shall not emanate or interfere with the peace and comfort of the surrounding residences or their guests, or the operators or customers in places of business in the vicinity.

*Fire*

11. Fire Department access shall be maintained at all times.
12. No open candles/flames are permitted.
13. Cords shall be taped down or covered for the duration of the event.

*Parking and Circulation*

14. The applicant may restrict traffic during the event at East Broad beach Road and Westward Beach Road, only after obtaining a Public Works encroachment permit. There shall be no lane closures, obstruction of public streets, parking restrictions or other encroachments into the public right of way without required prior approval and encroachment permits from the City of Malibu Public Works Department. Any issued Public Works permits shall be maintained on site and presented on request of any City employee or agent.
15. A traffic control plan shall be prepared by a licensed Civil or Traffic Engineer and shall be approved by Caltrans prior to the issuance of a City of Malibu Encroachment Permit. Such traffic control plan shall include all roads included in the event.
16. No signs shall be placed in the Caltrans right of way unless all required encroachment permits are first obtained from Caltrans. Copies of Caltrans encroachment permits will be submitted to the city prior to the event.
17. No signs shall be placed in the public right of way without a required City of Malibu encroachment permit. All signs placed in conjunction with the event shall be removed no later than 8:00 PM on September 18, 2022.
18. Applicant shall ensure temporary “NO PARKING” signs shall designate the dates and times the parking restrictions are to be enforced. Such signs shall be posted 72 hours in advance of parking restriction and shall be placed no more than 100 feet apart and at each end of the area to be restricted.
19. Guests will be directed to park at Zuma Beach Parking lot. Additional parking will be available at the High School parking lot, and along Pacific Coast Highway and Westward Beach Road in designated locations. Sufficient event staff and signage shall be provided to direct vehicles to the various parking locations.
20. Sufficient event staff shall be provided to assure that traffic does not back up onto Pacific Coast Highway or any public street and to assure the sound level is maintained at a level that does not disturb the peace of residents or tenants in the surrounding area. Event staff shall also monitor the pedestrian traffic crossing Pacific Coast Highway to assure that the public is safely crossing Pacific Coast Highway. In the event that the event staff notices the public crossing Pacific Coast Highway unsafely, they shall immediately notify the Los Angeles County Sheriff.
21. Applicant shall maintain signs throughout the period of time of placement to time of completion of event and is responsible for replacement of missing or damaged signs as directed by the City Engineer.
22. Applicant shall place two changeable message signs along Pacific Coast Highway and obtain the required encroachment permits from Caltrans for the signs. One changeable message sign shall be placed on the southbound shoulder along Pacific Coast Highway in the vicinity of the turnout area prior to Trancas Canyon Road. The second changeable message sign shall be placed on the northbound shoulder along

Pacific Coast Highway in the vicinity of Kanan Dume Road. Final CMS sign locations shall obtain final approval from Caltrans and be shown on the approved Traffic Control Plan set. The changeable message signs shall be placed (7) seven days prior to the event.

#### *Resources Management*

23. Applicant is required to properly manage and dispose of recyclables, trash, and associated litter generated during the event by providing an adequate number of recycling and trash containers. There shall be a minimum of one container for collection of recyclables located next to each trash container throughout the event.
24. Containers for collection of recyclables (including metal, glass, plastic, and paper) will be clearly delineated and labeled to ensure that all recyclable materials are properly processed.
25. All recyclables and trash shall be kept in leak-proof containers. Recyclables and trash shall be kept overnight in animal-proof containers with tightly closed lids. An adequate number of such containers shall be provided, and the contents disposed of in a sanitary and appropriate manner.
26. Applicant and all event contractors shall only contract with haulers permitted by the City to provide solid waste and recycling services within the City limits.
27. Pursuant to the State of California regulations, all large venues, and events (over 2000 people) shall report to the City of Malibu the tonnage of total waste material generated and the tonnage of material recycled. The goal of the State of California is to reduce quantity of materials disposed at landfills by 50 percent or more. The applicant and all event contractors are required to meet or exceed this goal. The Applicant shall report to the City of Malibu, in an approved format within ten days of the conclusion of the event, the total tons of material recycled and disposed from the event. The report shall include copies of detailed hauling receipts and related documentation. The Applicant shall present any recycling and debris facility receipts on request of any City employee or agent.
28. All material, including solids and liquids, are prohibited from entering the storm drain system. The applicant shall employ methods to prevent the discharge of materials to the storm drain system which may include screens or other equivalent methods to limit the deposit of litter or other materials.
29. The event grounds including parking areas and streets shall be left clean and free of litter and debris. The premises shall be returned to their pre-event condition. All event generated recyclables, trash, and associated litter must be picked up and removed at the conclusion of the event or subject to administrative citation.
30. The use or distribution of expanded polystyrene foam packaging also known as "Styrofoam", is prohibited. The applicant and all event contractors shall not use expanding polystyrene foam packaging for any aspect of their event including food preparation/distribution. The applicant shall comply with MMC Chapter 9.28. The applicant shall be responsible for informing vendors of this ban.
31. The use or distribution of plastic shopping bags (compostable and non-compostable) is prohibited. The Applicant and all event contractors shall not use plastic bags for any aspect of their event including food distribution, nor for any distribution of items or goods to be participants and/or attendees except as stated in MMC Chapter 9.28. Applicant shall comply with MMC Chapter 9.28 and will be responsible for informing vendors of this ban.

32. The sale or distribution of plastic/bioplastic straws, stirrers, and cutlery is prohibited. Applicant and all event contractors shall not use, sell, or distribute plastic/bioplastic straws, stirrers, and cutlery for any aspect of the event including food distribution. Non-plastic alternatives such as paper, sugar cane, or bamboo are allowed for straws, stirrers, and cutlery. Applicant shall comply with MMC Chapter 9.24 (Ban on Plastic Food Packaging and Other Plasticware) and shall be responsible for informing vendors of this ban.
33. Applicant shall provide cigarette receptacles and post designated smoking sections to ensure that smokers do not dispose of cigarettes on the ground, in the public roadway, on the beach, or in brush areas. Applicant shall comply with MMC Section 12.08.035.
34. No outdoor lighting is proposed during the event; therefore, none is permitted. Any portable lighting used during set-up and tear-down must be directed downwards and away from residential properties.

#### *Food and Beverage Service*

35. The event may include food prepared onsite if the food vendor has a current permit from the Los Angeles County Health Department. All potentially hazardous food items shall be maintained at property temperatures. Hot food shall be maintained at 135 degrees Fahrenheit or above; cold food shall be maintained at 41 degrees Fahrenheit or below. Adequate hand washing facilities shall be provided, and food handlers shall frequently wash hands with hot water and soap.
36. Any wastewater generated by food vendors or by portable hand washing stations shall be contained and properly disposed of.

#### *Restrooms*

37. Temporary bathroom facilities shall have a secondary containment and be sited and maintained to prevent any spills to the environment.
38. Temporary bathroom facilities shall be provided to accommodate all event attendees. One portable toilet shall be provided for each 150 persons. At least one of the restrooms shall be a unisex disabled accessible bathroom. Hand washing facilities shall be provided. Temporary bathrooms shall be properly maintained in sanitary conditions.

#### **Special Site Conditions**

39. The event shall comply with all State of California and Los Angeles County COVID-19 pandemic public health orders.
40. The following individual shall be available throughout the duration of the event, including set-up and cleanup of the event: Brennan Lindner – Cell Phone: (310)570-9501.

#### **Fixed Conditions**

41. If any required conditions are violated or if any law, statute, or ordinance is violated, this permit may be suspended, and the privileges granted shall lapse.
42. A copy of this permit shall be kept onsite and shall be produced on request of any agent of the City of Malibu, Los Angeles County Fire Department, Los Angeles County Mountain and Rural Sanitation District, or Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department.

43. If any additional information or agreements are needed, the applicant shall submit subsequent documents to satisfy these comments. If the applicant fails to produce the documents in a timely manner before the event, this Temporary Use Permit will be null and void.
44. By **September 12, 2022**, if any additional information or signed agreements are still pending, this permit shall be null and void.
45. Pursuant to MMC Section 17.68.080, this permit may be revoked if the Planning Director finds that one or more of the following conditions exists:
- Circumstances have been changed by the applicant to such a degree that one or more of the findings of fact contained in MMC Section 17.68.060 can no longer be made in a positive manner.
  - The temporary use permit was obtained in a fraudulent manner.
  - One or more conditions of the temporary use permit have not been fulfilled.
42. Violations of this permit are subject to administrative citations and fines pursuant MMC Chapter 1.10.
43. This permit and rights conferred in this approval shall not be effective until the applicant signs, notarizes and returns the Acceptance of Conditions Affidavit accepting the conditions of approval set forth herein. The applicant shall file this form with the Planning Department, no later than **September 12, 2022**.

### Local Appeal

Pursuant to Malibu Municipal Code Section 17.04.220 (Appeal of Action), a decision of the Planning Director may be appealed to the Planning Commission by an aggrieved person by written statement setting forth the grounds for appeal. An appeal shall be filed with the City Clerk within 10 days and shall be accompanied by an appeal form and filing fee, as specified by the City Council.
