Subject: Amendment to Agreement for Annual Street Sweeping Services

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Authorize the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 1 to Agreement with Venco Power Sweeping, Inc. (Venco) for street sweeping services under the City's Annual Street Sweeping Program.

FISCAL IMPACT: Funding in the amount of \$83,000 for this program was included in the Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 in Account No. 100-3001-5121 (Street Sweeping). Under a separate agreement, Caltrans reimburses the City for the costs of sweeping Pacific Coast Highway (PCH) and any associated administrative costs. Based on the agreement, the City receives approximately \$51,678 in reimbursements from Caltrans per year.

WORK PLAN: This item was included as item 8b in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

DISCUSSION: The Annual Street Sweeping program consists of sweeping City owned streets, City owned parking lots and the sweeping PCH within City limits. On October 8, 2018, the City Council entered into an agreement with Venco to provide street sweeping services as part of the City's annual street sweeping program.

The original agreement was for a term of two years and the Staff recommends amending the agreement for an additional three years. Venco has performed very well during the term of its agreement. Staff recommends executing Amendment No. 1 extending the term of the agreement for an additional three years. By executing Amendment No. 1, the level of service to the City will continue uninterrupted.

Staff recommends authorizing the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 1 to the agreement with Venco.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT is made and entered in the City of Malibu on September 29, 2020, by and between the CITY OF MALIBU, hereinafter referred to as City, and Venco Power Sweeping, Inc, hereinafter referred to as Consultant.

The City and the Consultant agree as follows:

RECITALS

A. On October 8, 2018, the City entered into an Agreement with Consultant to provide street sweeping services (the "Agreement").

B. The City desires to amend the Agreement to extend the term of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of their mutual promises, obligations and covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Section 2.0 – Term of Agreement, of the Agreement, is hereby extended to October 8, 2023.
2. The Parties agree that this Amendment will be considered signed when the signature of a party is delivered physically or by facsimile transmission or scanned and delivered via electronic mail. Such facsimile or electronic mail copies will be treated in all respects as having the same effect as an original signature.
3. All terms and conditions of the Agreement not amended by this Amendment No. 1 remain in full force and effect.
