Subject: Malibu Park Drainage Improvements Project – Reject Bids

RECOMMENDED ACTION: 1) Reject all bids received for the Malibu Park Drainage Improvements Project, Specification No. 2086; and 2) Direct staff to return all bid bonds to the bidders.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the rejection of bids. Funding for the project was included in Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 in Account No. 102-9220-5100 (Malibu Park Drainage Improvements Project) in the amount of \$600,000.

WORK PLAN: This item was included as item 2I in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

DISCUSSION: On October 15, 2020, the City advertised the project specifications for the Malibu Drainage Improvements Project through the formal competitive bidding process. Six contractors submitted bids on November 19, 2020.

Although the City has sufficient funding to award this project, there are several areas in the project design that can be modified to reduce costs. Staff recommends rejecting all bids, redesign the project to reduce costs and then re-bidding the project.
