Subject: Acceptance of the Dume Drive and Fernhill Drive Speed Hump Project

---

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** 1) Accept the work performed by J & H Engineering General Contractors, Inc. (J & H) for the Dume Drive and Fernhill Drive Speed Hump Project, Specification No. 2089 as complete; and 2) Authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** There is no fiscal impact with accepting the work complete. The construction costs for this project were included in the Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020.

**WORK PLAN:** This item was not included in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. However, Council directed staff to complete this project with the remaining funds from the Annual Street Maintenance project.

**DISCUSSION:** On July 13, 2020, Council provided staff with direction of installing speed humps on Dume Drive and Fernhill Drive between Grayfox Street and Cliffside Drive. On November 9, 2020, the Council awarded a construction contract to J & H for the Dume Drive and Fernhill Drive Speed Hump Project.

The work is now complete. Staff recommends the City Council accept the work performed by J & H and authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion for the project.

**STAFF FOLLOW-UP:** Upon acceptance by the City Council of the work associated with this contract, staff will request the recordation of the Notice of Completion with the Los

Angeles County Registrar/Recorder's Office which will allow the City to then release the retention monies following a required 35-day holding period.
