Subject: Boys & Girls Club of Malibu Event Fee Waiver

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Consider whether to approve the request from the Boys & Girls Club of Malibu to waive facility use fees and staffing costs for the Chili Cook-Off event at the Ioki Property.

FISCAL IMPACT: Waiving the facility use fees and staffing costs will result in a loss of revenue of \$20,848 for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in Account Numbers 100-0000-3461-00 (Municipal Facility Use Fees) and 103-0000-3505-00 (City Hall Use Fees).

The Malibu Municipal Code allows for only six TUPs (Temporary Use Permits) per parcel per calendar year. TUP events can generate revenue for the City, and waiving rental fees limits this revenue-generating potential.

WORK PLAN: This item was not included in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

DISCUSSION: The Boys and Girls Club of Malibu (BGCM) began coordinating the annual Chili Cook-Off at the Ioki Property in 2018. BGCM uses the event as a fundraiser to support local after-school programs at Malibu schools, including the Teen Center and Wellness Center at Malibu High School.

On June 22, 2021, BGCM submitted a TUP application to hold the Chili Cook-Off at the Ioki Property from September 2 through September 6, 2021. Setup for the event will begin on August 24, and post-event breakdown will continue through September 9. Additionally, BGCM will utilize the City Hall Parking Lot for parking from September 3 through September 6.

BGCM has requested the City waive 100% of the facility rental fees associated with the event, including:

Facility Use Fees	\$20,066
Staffing Fees	\$782

The Facility Use Fee Schedule approved by the City Council each year allows the City Manager to reduce facility use fees for applicants under unique circumstances; however, the City Council typically reviews larger requests such as this.

All other fees associated with the event, including permit fees and a facility deposit, have been paid by BGCM and are not a part of this request. Additionally, BGCM would be responsible for paying parking occupancy tax on the revenue generated from all parking fees. If approved, this event would be the second TUP issued for the loki property this year.
