Subject: Malibu Arts Association Event Fee Waiver

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Consider whether to approve the request from the Malibu Arts Association to waive facility use fees, staffing costs, and permit fees for five Art Show events at Legacy Park.

FISCAL IMPACT: Waiving the facility use and permit fees will result in a loss of revenue of \$6,390 for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in Account Numbers 100-0000-3461-00 (Municipal Facility Use Fees) and 100-0000-3421-00 (Planning Review Fees).

WORK PLAN: This item was not included in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

DISCUSSION: On July 12, 2021, Council approved a fee waiver for Malibu Arts Association (MAA) to conduct an Art Show at Legacy Park on August 8, 2021. MAA met the requirements for hosting the event, including the submittal of a Temporary Use Permit (TUP) and facility rental application. The Art Show featured fourteen artists and allowed MAA to raise funds for student scholarships and book purchases for the Malibu Library.

Due to the event's success, MAA has requested permission from the City to hold five additional events through the remainder of Fiscal Year 2021-2022. Two of the events would take place in September and October 2021 and the three remaining events would be held between January and June 2022. MAA has requested the City waive 100% of the fees associated with the events, including:

The Malibu Municipal Code allows up to six TUPs per parcel per calendar year. A total of three events will be permitted at Legacy Park in 2021. Staff will work with MAA to determine dates for three additional events, which would take place before June 30, 2022. Additionally, MAA has agreed to adhere to all TUP requirements, including the 35-day pre-event submittal deadline and public noticing.
