Subject: Acceptance of the Temporary Skate Park Equipment Installation Project

RECOMMENDED ACTION: 1) Accept the work performed by California Skateparks for the Temporary Skate Park Equipment Installation Project (Specification No. 2085) as complete; and 2) Authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact with accepting the work complete. The construction costs for this project were included in the Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. The City budgeted \$323,000 and the total costs of the project was \$284,680 with a cost savings of approximately \$38,319.

WORK PLAN: This item was included as item 8r in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

DISCUSSION: On April 13, 2020 the Council awarded a construction contract to California Skateparks for the Temporary Skate Park Equipment Installation Project.

The work is now complete. Staff recommends the City Council accept the work performed by California Skateparks and authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion for the project.

STAFF FOLLOW-UP: Upon acceptance by the City Council of the work associated with this contract, staff will request the recordation of the Notice of Completion with the Los

Angeles County Registrar-Recorder's Office, which will allow the City to then release the retention monies following a required 35-day holding period.
