Subject: <u>Clean Power Alliance</u>

<u>RECOMMENDED ACTION:</u> Receive and file a presentation from the Clean Power Alliance (CPA) regarding electricity service provided to Malibu, including customer participation, rates, and billing practices.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action.

WORK PLAN: CPA is Item 5g in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> Clean Power Alliance (CPA) is a locally controlled electricity provider in Southern California, which serves Malibu and 30 other communities. CPA purchases clean power and Southern California Edison (SCE) delivers it.

CPA Chief Executive Officer Ted Bardacke will provide a presentation to update the Council and community on the following:

- CPA and Malibu Overview, including customer participation in CPA service and community environmental performance
- Recent customer billing concerns, including SCE rate increases and December/January billing error
- CPA 2022-2023 rate outlook
- Transition of residential customers to Time of Use rates and CPA's 12-Month Bill Protection Plan
- CPA's local programs and opportunities for the City and its residents and businesses
