Subject: Parking Citation Fines

---

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** 1) Conduct the Public Hearing; 2) Review the Public Safety Commission's recommendation for increasing parking citation fines and establishing fines for violations of Malibu Municipal Code (MMC) 10.18 (Oversized Vehicles); and 3) Adopt Resolution No. 22-11 amending the City's Schedule of Parking Citation Penalties and finding the action to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** In Fiscal Year 2020-2021, the City received approximately \$1.367 million in revenue from parking citations. Staff is working with the City's citation processing vendor to develop an updated projection as the parking citation revenue is anticipated to increase moderately as a result of this action; however, an estimate is not available at this time.

**WORK PLAN:** This item was not included in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

**DISCUSSION:** On November 3, 2021, the Public Safety Commission performed its annual review of the City's parking citation fine schedule. The violations identified for possible fine increases were based on input from representatives from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) Lost Hills Station and the City's Volunteers on Patrol (VOP) due to their experience in enforcing vehicle codes and issuing citations. At that meeting, the Commission voted to recommend that the City Council increase the fines for 14 code violations, with six of the violations called out for substantial increases to \$150 due to their public safety impact and prevalence. The proposed increases were as follows:

However, after further research staff identified four other factors that need to be considered when assessing parking citation fines:

- The City typically aims to be consistent with the Las Virgenes Parking Authority (LVPA), and these recommended increases were not consistent with LVPA.
- California Vehicle Code Section 40203.5.(a) stipulates: "To the extent possible, issuing agencies within the same county shall standardize parking penalties." A parking fine comparison chart was prepared showing the fines charged for similar violations by other beach communities, two within Los Angeles County and three outside of the County. (Attachment 3).
- Fines that are too high and perceived as disproportionate to the offense have a greater chance of being appealed.
- Citation appeals incur additional staff and contractor costs.

In addition, high fines do not guarantee better compliance, particularly with visitors to the City. If compliance is the goal, better signage and public education could be a more effective deterrent. This is particularly true for fire hydrants that look different than the

standard hydrant people are familiar with. In 2021, 4,179 citations were written for this offense. It is unknown how many were due to misidentification of a fire hydrant, but this issue may benefit from improved signage or marking.

It is also important to note that in July 2020, the 9<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals affirmed in the case, *Pimentel vs. City of Los Angeles*, that parking tickets and fees must comply with the U.S. Constitution Eighth Amendment's ban on "excessive fines." The *Pimentel vs. City of Los Angeles* case was regarding a \$63 parking meter fine. To determine whether the fine was "grossly disproportional" to the offense, the court looked at four factors:

- 1) The nature and extent of the underlying offense
- 2) Whether the underlying offense related to other illegal activities
- 3) Whether other penalties may be imposed for the offense
- 4) The extent of the harm caused by the offense

Although the Court ultimately ruled that the \$63 fine was reasonable, the four factors used to determine the decision provide a valuable guide. The highest proposed fines are all directed toward violations that could impact the most serious public health and safety issues (*i.e.*, blocking roadways/lanes/sidewalks, impacting fire resources or blocking bicycle lanes which would force cyclists into car lanes). Thus, while it impossible to predict how a court may rule, thought and effort were given to the above factors to ensure constitutionality.

On January 5, 2022, the parking citation fines were brought back to the Public Safety Commission for second review. Staff recommended that the Commission consider the new factors identified by staff, including the four factors used in *Pimentel vs. City of Los Angeles* to determine if the recommended fine increases should be adjusted. After a thorough discussion, the Commission voted to re-affirm its original recommendation to the City Council citing safety concerns related to each of the violations.

On March 7, 2022, the Administration and Finance Subcommittee (Subcommittee) reviewed the proposed changes to the fines recommended by the Public Safety Commission. The Subcommittee did not make any changes to the recommendation and voted to have the City Council consider the matter.

In addition to considering everything defined above, violations that pertain to license plates (CVC 5200, 4457, 5201, 5201 (A)) may be particularly important in the future since the City will be installing Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR) cameras. A study done in 2012 by Texas A&M Transportation Institute found that "two plates increase the opportunities to identify vehicles (speed detection, stolen vehicles, red-light running, etc.)." In addition, since this violation results in a "fix-it" ticket, an elevated fine may increase the incentive for people to fix the plate.

### Establishing Fines and Penalties for MMC Section 10.18 (Oversized Vehicles)

On December 11, 2017, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 427, which implemented parking restrictions for commercial oversize vehicles and trailers, as well as noncommercial oversize vehicles and trailers citywide. In order to implement the Ordinance, a Coastal Development Permit (CDP) was required. On January 19, 2021, the Planning Commission adopted a resolution approving a CDP to install the associated regulatory signage at the City boundaries.

Adoption of Ordinance No. 427 added Chapter 10.18 to Title 10 (Vehicles and Traffic) to the MMC. However, under MMC 10.18, parking fines and penalties must be established by resolution of the city, which has not been done. Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and the Volunteers on Patrol have been enforcing the ordinance, but because there are currently no fines associated with MMC 10.18, they frequently use Los Angeles County Code 15.20.070 for failing to obey signs, such as a red curb or parking in a "no parking any time" zone.

Therefore, when the Public Safety Commission performed its annual review of the parking citation fine schedule, the Commission also voted to recommend that the City Council establish a fine for violations of MMC Section 10.18 (Oversized Vehicles) as follows:

- 1) A fine not exceeding \$100 for a first violation;
- 2) A fine not exceeding \$200 for a second violation within one year; and
- 3) A fine not exceeding \$500 for each additional violation within one year and note that a continuation of any violation of this chapter on successive days constitutes a separate offense for each day during any portion of which such violation has occurred.

Staff recognizes the challenge in balancing the need to protect public safety with encouraging compliance and the administrative costs of appeals. Therefore, staff recommends that the Council carefully consider the public safety interest, the potential impacts on staff resources, as well as public education options, and adopt the recommended fines as stated or adjust some or all of them. In addition, since a resolution establishing a fine for violations of MMC 10.18 has not been brought to the City Council for adoption, staff recommends that Resolution No. 22-11 be adopted to include the increased fines for the indicated violations and the new fines for MMC 10.18 as recommended by the Public Safety Commission. Staff and the Commission believe that an escalating fine schedule for violations of the oversize vehicle ordinance will help discourage repeat offenders and encourage compliance with the ordinance.

## RESOLUTION NO. 22-11

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MALIBU AMENDING THE CITY'S SCHEDULE OF PARKING CITATION FINES, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 21-21, AND FINDING THE ACTION TO BE EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

The City Council of the City of Malibu does hereby find, order and resolve as follows:

#### SECTION 1. Recitals.

A. California Vehicle Code Section 40200 *et seq.* authorizes cities to impose and collect civil fines and penalties for violations of any regulation pertaining to the stopping, standing, or parking of a vehicle, and related charges, as specified in the California Vehicle Code, any federal statute or regulation, or any local ordinance; and

B. California Vehicle Code section 40203.5 requires cities to establish a schedule of penalties for parking violations and related charges; and Malibu Municipal Code (MMC) section 10.12.060 states that parking citation fines shall be established by resolution of the City. These fines are detailed in the City's Parking Citation Fine Schedule (Schedule) for violations of that ordinance. The Schedule indicates the related Los Angeles County Code (LACC) Section and, where appropriate, the California Vehicle Code (CVC) as referenced.

C. On April 26, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 21-21, amending the City's Schedule to include both Los Angeles County Codes and California Vehicle Codes.

D. At its Regular meetings on November 3, 2021 and January 5, 2022, the Public Safety Commission reviewed the Schedule and considered input from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) Lost Hills Station and Volunteers on Patrol (VOP), as well as City Finance and Public Safety staff.

E. It was discussed that current rates often do not act as a deterrent to motorists choosing to park illegally or bypass car license plate requirements, so the Commission suggested certain fines be increased to \$58 or \$98, and those with the biggest public safety concern to \$150.

F. The Commission recommended that the Council approve the following revisions to the Schedule:

G. At its Regular meeting on November 3, 2021, the Public Safety Commission also recommended that the Council approve the following fine schedule for violations of MMC 10.18 (Oversized Vehicles):

1. A fine not exceeding \$100 for a first violation;
2. A fine not exceeding \$200 for a second violation within one year; and
3. A fine not exceeding \$500 for each additional violation within one year; and note that a continuation of any violation of this chapter on successive days constitutes a separate offense for each day during any portion of which such violation has occurred.

SECTION 2. The City of Malibu hereby rescinds Resolution No. 21-21.

SECTION 3. The Schedule of Parking Citation Penalties attached hereto as Exhibit 1 was amended to include the increases in parking fines stated above and the new fines for violations of MMC 10.18 and is hereby adopted.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
