Subject: City Council Appointments to City Commissions and Committees

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

- 1) Councilmembers Riggins and Stewart to each make an appointment to the Malibu Arts Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, Planning Commission, Public Safety Commission, Public Works Commission, and Wastewater Advisory Committee;
- 2) Councilmembers Riggins and Stewart to each make two appointments to the Homelessness Task Force;
- 3) Council may appoint or affirm appointments of an ex officio member to the Cultural Arts Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, and Public Safety Commission;
- 4) Council to appoint or affirm two at-large appointments to the Wastewater Advisory Committee;
- 5) Council to appoint or affirm five appointments and two alternate appointments to the Building Board of Appeals; and
- 6) Council to defer appointment of members to the Mobilehome Park Rent Stabilization Commission until such a time as it is necessary for the Commission to meet.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action.

<u>WORK PLAN:</u> This item was not included in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. This is part of normal staff operations.

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> Pursuant to Malibu Municipal Code (MMC) Title 2, Council appointments to various City Commissions run concurrently with the appointing Councilmember's term. Therefore, following the election, each newly elected Councilmember appoints Commission members. Individuals may serve on only one commission, board, or committee at any given time, in accordance with Council Policy No. 48 – Opportunity to

Serve (adopted February 25, 2013). However, this stipulation was waived for appointments to the Homelessness Task Force when the Task Force was formed.

Appointments to the Harry Barovsky Memorial Youth Commission are at-large, run for one year at a time, and last occurred at the May 9, 2022 City Council meeting.

Following are the existing appointments on City Commissions. Members appointed by former Councilmembers Farrer and Pierson will continue to serve until replaced or reappointed and are listed only for reference. Staff verified that all applications attached to the staff report meet various criteria for appointment.

Malibu Arts Commission:

The Malibu Arts Commission differs from other City Council Commissions in that MMC Section 2.26.030 states that an interview process shall precede appointments. Any applicants have been invited to attend this meeting, so they may be called on to answer questions the Council may have pursuant to the interview requirement outlined in the MMC. Pursuant to MMC Section 2.26.020, a member of the Malibu Arts Commission shall be a resident of the City. The City Council may appoint one ex officio member who lives outside the City limits but within the 90265-zip code area and shall not have a vote on the Commission.

Mobilehome Park Rent Stabilization Commission:
