Subject: City Council Appointments to City Commissions and Committees

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

- 1) Councilmembers Riggins and Stewart to each make an appointment to the Malibu Arts Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, Planning Commission, Public Safety Commission, Public Works Commission, and Wastewater Advisory Committee;
- 2) Councilmembers Riggins and Stewart to each make two appointments to the Homelessness Task Force
- 3) Council may appoint or affirm appointments of an ex officio member to the Cultural Arts Commission, Parks and Recreation Commission, and Public Safety Commission;
- 4) Council to appoint or affirm two at-large appointments to the Wastewater Advisory Committee;
- 5) Council to appoint or affirm five appointments and two alternate appointments to the Building Board of Appeals; and
- 6) Council to defer appointment of members to the Mobilehome Park Rent Stabilization Commission until such a time as it is necessary for the Commission to meet.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the recommended action.

WORK PLAN: This item was not included in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. This is part of normal staff operations.

DISCUSSION: On December 29, 2022, the original agenda report was distributed. Seven City Commission/Committee Member Applications were received after that time, which are attached to this report.

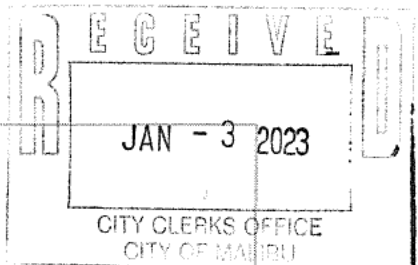
Staff verified that all applications attached to the staff report meet various criteria for appointment.

I earned my B.S. in Civil Engineering and an M.B.A. with honors from Michigan State University, which is considered to be among the top five universities in the U.S. for Civil Engineering. I have been a Member of the American Society of Civil Engineers and have been employed as a Project Engineer on many projects including Mountaingate in the Sepulveda Pass, and many other streets, storm drains, sewer lines, grading jobs, retaining walls from two feet to 32 feet in height, etc. My education and extensive experience with respect to geology, soils engineering, and hydrology provides me with a high level of understanding with respect to sands, clays, gravels, and various rock formations, and the ability of these materials to allow percolation and filtration of effluent. The chemical engineering courses I have taken have given me knowledge of how different wastewater treatment systems eliminate solids, nitrates, phosphates and bacteria.

I provided engineering services and worked as a project engineer for developers for eight years prior to starting my own engineering and land development consulting company in Malibu in 1980.

Throughout my 40+ years of professional experience more than 60% of my time has been devoted to projects in the City of Malibu, and 98% of these projects involved Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems. I have participated in the design of many types of wastewater treatment systems, including residential septic systems, package treatment plants, and commercial building systems, as well as larger community treatment plants.

I have chaired the Committee for more than twenty-two years and have not missed a meeting. The Wastewater Advisory Committee works at the pleasure of the City Council and it is the City Council, with the oversight of Malibu's Environmental Health Administrator, Dr. Andrew Sheldon, that calls on the Committee to investigate and analyze new technologies that may clean effluent to a higher level and which could be applicable to the City's 13,500+/- residents. Issues such as different ways to eliminate phosphate and nitrate pollutants are proposed and analyzed. Other issues such as disinfection systems and odor pollution are considered, and creative solutions are discussed and implemented. All of the members of the Wastewater Advisory Committee are passionate about their service to the community and their role in finding new and creative ways to treat wastewater with the goal of creating clean effluent that can be used as an asset that will reduce water and fertilizer consumption. Simply stated, the role of the Committee is to help the City, through the City Council, to develop the best wastewater treatment systems in the world and find solutions that will eliminate any kind of pollution resulting from wastewater treatment systems, along with the goal of reducing water consumption.

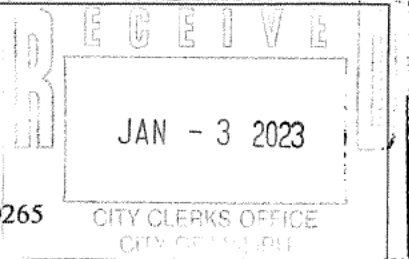
