Subject: Acceptance of Broad Beach Road Biofiltration Repair Project

RECOMMENDED ACTION: 1) Accept the work performed by JTEC Corporation, Inc. for the Broad Beach Road Biofiltration Repair Project, Specification No. 2091 as complete; and 2) Authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact with accepting the work complete. This project was included in the Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 in Account No. 102-9212-5100.00 (Broad Beach Road Water Quality Improvements).

WORK PLAN: This item was included as item 2.g. in the Adopted Work Plan for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

DISCUSSION: On June 13, 2022, City Council awarded the Broad Beach Road Biofiltration Repairs Project to JTEC Corporation. This project included the repair of the existing storm water biofilters, landscaping and permeable pavers on Broad Beach Road. These items were damaged from the storms following the Woolsey Fire.

The work is now complete. Staff recommends the City Council to accept the work performed by JTEC Corporation and authorize the Public Works Director to submit for recordation a Notice of Completion for the project.

STAFF FOLLOW-UP: Upon acceptance by the City Council of the work associated with this contract, staff will record the Notice of Completion with the Los Angeles County

Registrar/Recorder's Office which will allow the City to then release the retention monies following a required 35-day holding period.
